



Cochran's 2025 Ski Sale Consignment Agreement

CONSIGNMENT DROP OFF: Consignors **MUST** be able to drop off all consigned items to Camel's Hump Middle School (CHMS; 173 School Street, Richmond) on Friday, November 7th between 6:00pm and 8:30pm. You will receive a drop-off receipt at this time. There will be no other opportunity for gear drop-off.

CONSIGNMENT / CHECK PICK UP: Consignment checks and / or unsold gear **MUST** be picked up at CHMS on Sunday, November 9th from 1:30pm - 3:00pm. In order to receive payment for sold items and / or pick-up unsold consigned items, you must bring your drop-off receipt. There will be no other opportunity for pick up.

Cochran's 2025 Ski & Ride Sale online consignment is open Wednesday October 22nd through Tuesday November 4th at midnight. We accept consignments of new and gently-used ski, snowboard and winter athletic clothing (no street clothing please), modern alpine and snowboard equipment, snowshoes, backcountry, telemark, and Nordic and cross-country skis. All equipment must meet safety standards. NOTE: For safety reasons, we are unable to accept helmets.

Items marked with the "Sunday Special" discount will be priced at 20% off the ticketed price if sold on Sunday, November 9th. You, the consignor, will receive 80% of the **sale amount** of your items that are sold. We, Cochran's Ski Club, will retain a 20% commission of the sale amount of sold items. You may also choose to donate your commission, for which we thank you.

You agree to represent your consigned items accurately on the consignment platform. Cochran's Ski Club reserves the right to reject consigned items on site at consignment drop-off if they do not meet our item category, minimum price, or quality requirements.

Cochran's Ski Club assumes no responsibility for damage, theft, or loss of items consigned to the sale. **Any unsold items that are not claimed on the afternoon of Sunday, November 9th will become property of Cochran's Ski Club.**

Cochran's Ski Club enlists the support of a 3rd party to review bindings on consigned skis for indemnification purposes. We reserve the right to reject non-indemnified skis at gear drop-off on Friday evening and / or mark the skis as "Non-Indemnified" on the sales floor so our shoppers can make informed purchasing decisions. Most ski shops will refuse to work on non-indemnified bindings for liability reasons, so buyers may be unable to find a shop willing to adjust them. In addition, non-indemnified bindings tend to be older, experiencing plastic degradation, moisture issues, as well as repeated freezing and thawing which all can negatively impact performance.
